

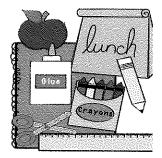

Please be sure to provide your child with "at home" supplies such as scissors, glue sticks, crayons and pencils.

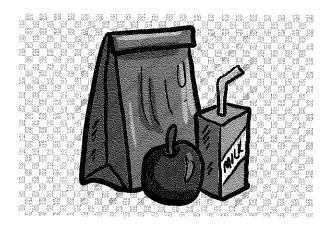
We would appreciate the following materials being purchased to supplement materials needed for the student and teacher throughout the year.

### Healthy Snacks

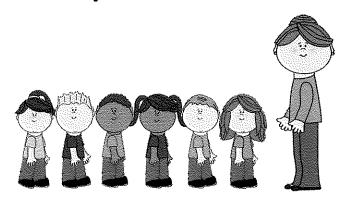


The Kindergarten students will be having snack time daily. Please send in their snack in a separate bag from their lunch. Below is a list of suggested healthy snacks:
