

## **COPS Editing Checklist**

Use the following checklist as a guide when you edit your writing. Also, use it when you are ready to proofread your final draft.

| CAPITALIZ | ZATION  |
|-----------|---|
|           | Start all sentences with a capital letter Capitalize nouns that name specific people, places, and things (proper nouns)   |
| ORGANIZA  | TION  |
|           | Sentences should be clear and complete (combine simple sentences without creating a run-on sentence)  Edit run-on sentences into 2 or more complete sentences Check that you have included a variety of sentence structures (having different lengths, using various introductory clauses/endings, effective use of transition words) Use powerful verbs, specific nouns, and colorful adjectives/adverbs |
| PUNCTUAT  | TION  |
|           | Each sentence should end with an appropriate punctuation mark ( . ! ?)  Use commas after introductory clauses and transition words  Use commas in a series (Larry, Moe, and Curly)  Use commas before connecting words (and, but, or) in compound sentences  Punctuate dialogue correctly (Mary said, "I did my homework!")   |
| SPELLING  |   |
|           | Did I check for spelling (use spell check) Check for homonyms and make sure you used the correct form (too or to or two and your or you're)   |
