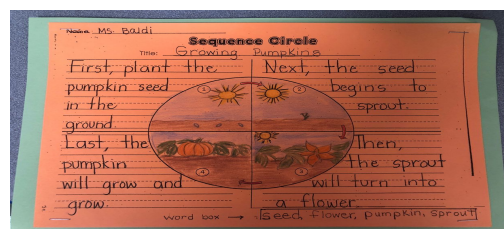
## Fire Safety Assembly
