We would like to prepare the students for the 2020-2021 school year and in doing so, we suggest you purchase the following supplies for your child. An assignment pad will be provided for your child by the district. A list of essential supplies follows:

Essential Supplies:

- 1 Single subject spiral notebook for Robotics
- 1 Single subject spiral notebook for Science
- 1 5-Subject (or the most pages possible) spiral notebook for Mathematics
- 1 plastic folder with pockets and prongs. College ruled loose leaf paper, earbuds or headphones and colored pencils and dry erase markers (Spanish)
- 1 Composition book for Language Arts
- 2 1 in. three ring binders (Reading and Language Arts)
- 1 8-pocket accordion folder organizer (one of these folders will be used for Social Studies, one will be used for 1 marking period of STEM)
