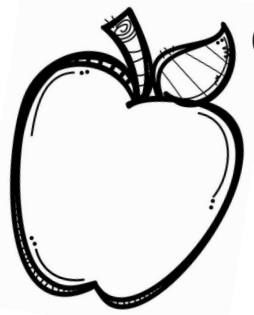

learned about the Korean and Chinese customs for the Lunar New Year. Thank you to all the parents, students, and participants that were involved in the celebration!



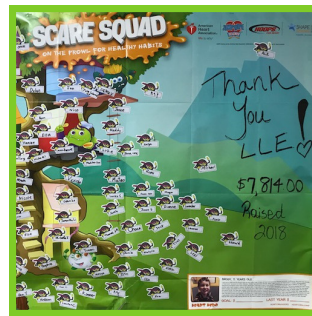
HARLEM WIZARDS!

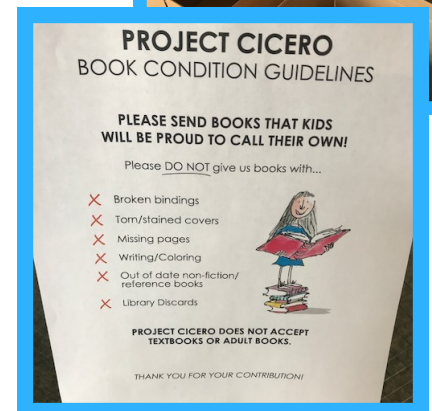
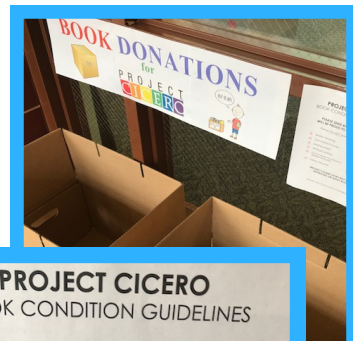
Book Donations:
