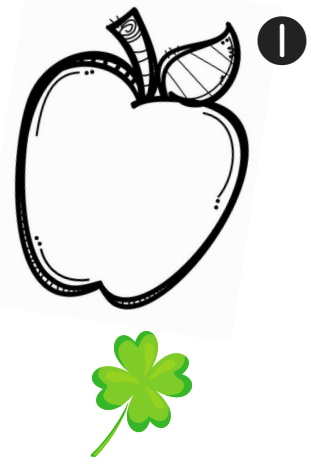
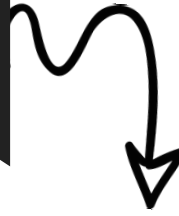

International Day

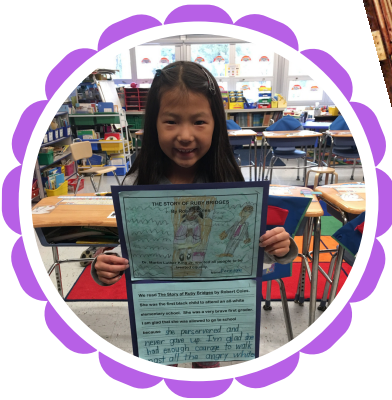
On Saturday, March 17th, Demarest schools will be participating in International Heritage Day.
