### Reminder: LLE New Entry and Exit Procedures

#### ARRIVAL:

Drop off is from 8:05-8:25 and homeroom will start at 8:05. Students must exit the car quickly so that the car line can continue to move.

Students Enter the Building:

- Second Grade - Main entrance (by the Main Office)
- Third Grade - Lenox Avenue (Back of school entrance)
- Fourth Grade - Lower entrance by the Music Room (front of the building)

#### DISMISSAL:

- Students whose last name begin with **A-J** will dismiss out the **front** of the building at **12:20**.
- Students whose last name begin with **K-Z** will dismiss out the **back** of the building, the Lenox Avenue exit at **12:30**.
- Students must wear facial coverings while exiting the building and waiting for their ride.

### Reminder: CRS New Entry and Exit Procedures

#### ARRIVAL:

Drop off is from 8:05-8:25 and homeroom will start at 8:05. Students must exit the car quickly so that the car line can continue to move. Preschool students will park and will be walked by their parents to their corresponding classroom.

Students Enter the Building:

- Preschool- park and walked by their parent
- Kindergarten- Gym entrance

#### DISMISSAL:

## Health Tips

One of the biggest things to remember when staying healthy and safe is to wash your hands properly. It is important to practice with your children to make sure they are doing it properly. Here are the steps:
