

# Demarest School District Lunch Program

## Frequently Asked Questions

1. How Can I purchase lunch tickets?  
Lunch tickets can be purchase through our online payment system, PaySchools. The link to the portal is <https://www.payschoolscentral.com/>. You can also access PaySchools through our school district's website by clicking on the payment portal tab. Tickets must be purchased in increments of \$55 (10 tickets per sheet).
2. Can I use lunch tickets that were purchased in the 2019-2020 school year?  
Yes
3. Can I use lunch tickets interchangeably between all schools?  
Yes
4. What happens if my child forgets to bring their **lunch ticket** to school?  
Your student should get online for lunch as usual and let the lunch staff know they forgot the ticket. Have your student bring two tickets the following day.
5. What happens if my child forgets to bring their **lunch** to school?  
Your student will be provided with a choice of a bagel or cereal with fruit and a drink. Your Payschools account will be billed for the meal.
6. Can I drop my students lunch off at the school?  
No, parents will not be permitted to drop lunch off at school. If your child forgets their lunch Please refer to question 5 above.
7. Can I order lunch from any place I want and have it delivery to the school?  
No, you can place an order with an approved vendor only. They are Yasou Mykonos for all schools, Demarest Deli for Luther Lee Elementary and Demarest Middle School. **Starting October 4<sup>th</sup>** Demarest Middle School can order from Isabella's as well.
8. How do I place a lunch order with an approved vendor?  
Place your lunch order directly with one of the approved vendors listed in question #7
9. Where can I find the monthly lunch menu?  
Menus are available on our district website under the Lunch tab.
10. Is lunch served on minimum days?

11. Is the menu the same for all three schools?  
Yes
12. Will we be selling snacks at lunch?  
We hope to be able to sell ice cream, chips, and approved cookies by the end of September. We will send a notice to the parents when snacks are available.
